

Instructions for full paper submission

The following are the instructions to authors for the full paper submission:

Log in to your Microsoft CMT profile and click on “Practical GYAN on STEM- A residential STEM conference for CBSE School teachers (PRAGYAN-2026)” under the “My Conferences” tab.

Alternatively, you can log in to your Microsoft CMT IAES-2026 Conference page directly at: <https://cmt3.research.microsoft.com/PRAGYAN2026>.

Then “Select Your Role” as “Author” at the top of the page to view reviewers’ comments against your paper(s).

You need to upload three new files to complete full paper submission.

1. Full paper manuscript in DOCX format. MAX PAGE LIMIT- 6.
2. Full paper manuscript in PDF format. MAX PAGE LIMIT- 6.
3. An Abstract file for the Book of Abstracts in DOCX format. ABSTRACT HAS A STRICT 200-WORD LIMIT.

A separate file highlighting author guidelines for the preparation of the full paper and the templates for both full paper and abstract files are provided at <https://school.vssc.gov.in/PRAGYAN/>

The full paper manuscript filename should be “PRAGYAN-2026-Paper ID” and abstract filename should be “PRAGYAN -2026-ABSTRACT-Paper ID”. THE FULL PAPER SHOULD NOT EXCEED SIX PAGES.

The Paper ID can be found in the “Author Console” page (first column) in the Microsoft CMT PRAGYAN 2026 Conference page.

Upload ALL THREE files by clicking the “Edit Submission” link under “Actions- Submissions” against your submission.

Upload the files in the “Files” section, answer the questions therein, and click the “Save Changes” button to complete the submission.

Date for final submission

The submission of the full paper is due by **April 15, 2026**. Due to the high volume of submitted papers and the limited time available for review, no extension will be granted for the deadline for full paper submissions.

Proceedings publication

Conference proceedings will be published within 12–16 weeks after the conference. Please note that only high-quality papers from the conference will be considered for inclusion in this publication. Authors are therefore strongly encouraged to ensure a high level of originality and quality in their submissions.

Full Paper Review Process

All submitted full papers will undergo a rigorous peer-review process conducted by two independent reviewers. The final decision on your paper will be based on the reviewers’ comments and recommendations.

During the review, the following criteria will be carefully evaluated:

- The work demonstrates originality and novelty.

- The study design and methodology are appropriate and clearly described, enabling replication by other researchers.
- The results are presented clearly and appropriately.
- The conclusions are reliable, significant, and well supported by the research findings.

Authors are requested to conduct a plagiarism check including AI plagiarism prior to submission and ensure that the similarity index is within 10%.

Please note that the Conference Technical Committee will independently check the plagiarism of all submitted papers.

We appreciate your cooperation in maintaining high academic and ethical standards.

Acceptance of full paper

If you address the reviewers' comments appropriately and comply with all the above guidelines, we will consider your manuscript for ORAL/POSTER presentation.
